Description: This is paper made from the very thin bark of the tree *Betula utilis*.

Use: The tree bark of *Betula utilis* was the most commonly used material for writing. Several ancient texts and manuscripts have been written on 'Bhojpatra'.

Used by: People of Chamoli district of Garhwal region in Uttarakhand, India, in the Central Himalayas.
